A CICC Member company is wishing to investigate the possibility of bringing polymer decomposition technology to the western United States market. The company would like to find a suitable west coast partner familiar with the petro-chemical climate in California and neighboring states.

The company has extensive knowledge and experience with polymer decomposition technology and can accompany an off-site cleaning/remediation operation that may already be available in California. The decomposition process is typically used in cleaning various types of hydrocarbon process equipment, not limited to tube heat exchangers, and can also be applicable to investment recovery.

The demand for real estate is not large and a conventional oven would not be anticipated to require more than 1000 square feet. This process does require water for oven seals and for a final rinse of ash deposits before the process equipment goes back into service, or the materials go to reclamation.

Estimated cost for a thermal decomposition oven will be approximately \$2,000,000 excluding water reclamation and any other associated equipment that may want to be added in order to market this as a turn-key solution to maintenance and final retirement.
