- **Traffic Alert** –The [Imagine Justice Concert](#) is scheduled for this Monday, August 21st, to be held at Capitol Mall with doors opening at 4:00pm and the concert starting at 5:00pm and runs until 10:00pm. Street closures scheduled for Sunday and Monday mornings will affect downtown travel. **Please be advised that 25,000 and 30,000 extra people downtown are anticipated - so plan accordingly and be safe.**

Related Cross - Street Closures - Monday, August 21st

- 9:30 a.m. Capitol Mall between 5th and 8th Streets will be closed.
- 9:30 a.m. 6th Street between L and Capitol Mall will be closed.
- 9:30 a.m. 7th and 8th Street between L and N Streets will be closed (9th Street between N and L Streets will be closed on Sunday and Monday)
- 2:00 p.m. 10th Street between L and N Streets will be closed.
- 6:00 a.m. Tuesday, August 22nd - all streets will re-open

The concert is unlikely to affect anyone on Monday morning, or those coming from Sacramento Airport in the afternoon and staying at the Hyatt Hotel. It could impact individuals headed home after dinner at Lucca's, who try to access downtown onramps to westbound I-80 or southbound I-5. It might also affect individuals staying at the Embassy Suites or downtown Holiday Inn. The concert runs until 10:00 pm and our dinner and Lucca's will breakup between 8:30 – 9:00pm. This will hopefully allow time to avoid the rush. We do not anticipate any meeting schedule interruptions on August 22nd or 23rd.
